Day 1. Arrive Victoria.

Take an eco-trek to Lost Lake; enjoy a floatplane flight; explore Whistler Mountain on a snowcat adventure; enjoy a mountain Jeep safari; ride the Peak 2 Peak Gondola; or set out on a tree trek or zip trek.

Day 5. Whistler, Sun Peaks.

Bid farewell to Whistler after breakfast this morning and travel through the lush Coast Mountains as you follow the historic tracks of the early gold rush pioneers through the Cariboo region. Make a stop at both Duffey and Seton lakes, travel via the rural town of Lillooet, then arrive in Sun Peaks. Canada's second-largest ski area, this lovely village is set beneath three famous summits.

Stay: Sun Peaks Grand Hotel.

Day 6. Sun Peaks, Blue River, Mt Robson, Jasper.

☞ On arrival in Blue River, board a custom-designed boat and skim over the waterways, watching for the grizzly and black bears that are frequently sighted here, as well as other native creatures. Afterwards, join the Yellowhead Highway and before crossing into Alberta, stop to take in views of the south face of Mt Robson, the highest peak in the Rockies. Today's journey concludes on arrival at the Fairmont Jasper Park Lodge in the heart of beautiful Jasper National Park. **Two Night Stay:** Jasper National Park, Fairmont Jasper Park Lodge.

CANADA'S AWE-INSPIRING ROCKY MOUNTAINS

Day 7. Jasper.

  With our Freedom of Choice activities, it's your decision as to how you'll spend your morning. Perhaps take a Harley-Davidson motorcycle sidecar tour, embark on a Maligne Valley experience, go rafting down the Athabasca River or ride the Jasper Tramway. You may prefer to set out on an interpretive nature hike or perhaps take part in an evening wildlife discovery. You then have time to relax before tonight's activity – a **stylish alfresco barbecue dinner by the shores of Trefoil Lake accompanied with beautiful rhythms from First Nations performers.** BD

Day 8. Jasper, Athabasca Glacier, Lake Louise.

See the spectacular Maligne Canyon, the deepest canyon in Jasper National Park, before joining the Icefields Parkway and winding through the Canadian Rockies. After pausing to take in Athabasca Falls, stop

at the Columbia Icefield. Here, you'll board a specially designed Ice Explorer vehicle and journey onto the surface of Athabasca Glacier. Later, stroll along the Glacier Skywalk, before admiring Peyto Lake en route to Lake Louise. **Two Night Stay:** Banff National Park, Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise in a Lakeview Room. B

Day 9. Lake Louise, Moraine Lake.

  Today you'll explore the World Heritage-listed landscapes of Banff National Park. First, experience the impossibly blue waters of Moraine Lake. **Then, join an expert Mountain Heritage Guide and learn about the rich natural history of the area as you take a leisurely stroll along the shores of Lake Louise.** Enjoy a Freedom of Choice Dining evening within your hotel. Day 10. Lake Louise, Banff.

Day 19. Skagway.

Reach the Inside Passage's northernmost point, Skagway. Once a gateway city for the Klondike Gold Rush, Skagway's frontier-style atmosphere remains evident today. Disembark and explore as you please. BLD

Day 20. Glacier Bay National Park.

Day 1. Arrive Vancouver, Great Bear Lodge.

Your bear-viewing adventure begins as you fly from Vancouver to Port Hardy. Here, board a seaplane and fly over Queen Charlotte Strait to Great Bear Lodge, a vast and remote floating oasis located in a region known as the Great Bear Rainforest. Accommodating very few guests, this is one of the few places on Earth where bears outnumber humans. Your grizzly bear experience begins in the late afternoon. Based on where the bears have been most active recently, your biologist guides will take you by boat to the estuary viewing sites or lead you to the river viewing sites. While you survey your surroundings for that tell-tale rustling, your guides will share information about the ecosystem and grizzly bear body language. Viewing sessions typically last for three hours and are not at all strenuous. Whether you're floating silently along the banks of the estuary, huddled in a rainforest-enveloped viewing platform or following tracks along a wilderness trail, there's nothing quite like the feeling of glimpsing your first bear as it emerges from within the

dense forest. Back at your lodge, wilderness-gourmet meals await. After dinner, enjoy a presentation explaining the interaction of grizzly bears within this environment.

Three Night Stay: Great Bear Lodge in a private room. D

Day 2. Great Bear Lodge.

Rise at dawn and head out again to search for grizzly bears. Although grizzlies are without a doubt the star of the show, Great Bear Rainforest is also home to a range of other fascinating creatures thanks to its ancient old-growth timber habitats. Wolves, bears, cougars and ever-adorable pine martens are found in the forest, while bald eagles watch from the sky. In the glacier-fed waters, meanwhile, river otters duck and dive for spawning salmon. After lunch, you'll set out to explore the area with a knowledgeable guide. A popular activity is the interpretive rainforest walk, during which bear signs and the ecology of the area are explained in detail. Afterwards, return to the lodge and enjoy some time to relax – perhaps you might like to unwind in front of the fireplace with a book from the natural history library or recline on the deck with a drink, enjoying the sounds of the rainforest. Later, rejoin your group and head out into the wilderness on your afternoon bear viewing session. BLD

Day 3. Great Bear Lodge.

Having already spent two nights at the lodge, you will have well and truly settled in to the rhythm of life in the remote British Columbia wilderness. On your final day, you'll once again descend into Great Bear Rainforest on morning and afternoon excursions. You may head out to explore the islands and long fjords, or stay ashore watching for wildlife between mountains and ancient old-growth timber forest. Between your bear viewing sessions, your guides may take you to explore the glacier-carved inlet, alive with silvery flashes of salmon, or you may prefer to relax and soak up your last few moments of tranquillity at the lodge. BLD

Day 4. Great Bear Lodge, Port Hardy.

Embark on your final bear viewing session this morning. Take lunch back at the lodge, then transfer by seaplane to Port Hardy, a haven for outdoor enthusiasts.

They may be varied by advertising or special offers, or changed after the publication date for any reason, including without limitation, to cover changes in government taxes and charges, exchange rate variations, fuel surcharges, airline charges, a force majeure event or other material increases by suppliers. Prices will be confirmed at time of booking and honoured for up to seven days. Once the security deposit is paid the price will be guaranteed. A non-refundable APT security deposit of \$1,000 per person, per holiday package is required within seven days of receipt of booking confirmation. A second non-refundable deposit of \$2,000 per person is due by 30 November 2018. Final payment of the balance of your holiday package price is due 110 days prior to departure unless otherwise stated in the terms of a special offer. APT reserves the right to cancel any ticket or booking or to refuse to honour any price or carry any passenger where payment has not been received by APT within the specified time. All fares and charges are in Australian currency. Payment in full is required at time of booking for reservations made less than 109 days before departure from Australia. If APT is unable to confirm your reservation, all monies will be refunded.

Included in Holiday Package Price

A limited number of single rooms are available by request at time of booking. Solo supplement must be paid with final payment.

Passengers Needing Special Assistance

APT welcomes passengers with disabilities or special needs however, please note the following:

1. Any disability or medical condition requiring special attention must be reported to APT at the time of booking including all important information relating to your health, mobility and fitness which may affect your partial or total participation in the cruise or tour. This information is also crucial to allow APT to ensure the tour you have chosen is suitable and meets your needs. Any changes to health, mobility and fitness must also be reported to APT as soon as possible and prior to departure. Where possible APT will make reasonable adjustments to the tour to accommodate your special needs however, it cannot do so if the adjustment required would be unreasonable in all of the circumstances, including if such adjustments would affect your safety and/or the safety and/or enjoyment of other passengers.

2. If you require special assistance or care (such as pushing a wheelchair, assistance with dressing or assistance with walking), you must travel with a companion capable of providing the required assistance or care.

Please be aware that APT does not provide personal assistance. APT is unable to assist any passenger with walking, dining, boarding or disembarking any transportation vehicles (including river and ocean cruise ships and trains). To safely participate in embarkation and disembarkation you must be able to do so without the need for special assistance. You must also be able to do so without unreasonably impacting other passengers' safety and/or enjoyment.

3. While APT will make reasonable efforts to accommodate the special needs of disabled passengers, it is not responsible for any denial of services by any third party entities it has travel arrangements with, such as carriers, hotels, trains, restaurants or other independent suppliers, or for any additional associated expenses charges by those parties.

4. Please note coaches and minibuses are not equipped with wheelchair ramps. Most river and ocean ships have elevators, however not all APT ships have elevators. Many ships require the use of stairs to go between decks. Further, side by side docking may require passengers to climb and descent stairs to cross over vessels to disembark and embark at times. APT ships often sail through remote areas that do not have convenient docking facilities. In such circumstances it will be necessary for passengers to negotiate temporary gangplanks and uneven surfaces. If the crew decide that it is not safe for a passenger to negotiate such operations they may require passengers to stay on board. Cabin doors and restrooms may not be wide enough to allow access by standard wheelchairs. Wheelchairs and walkers cannot be carried on coaches, due to space limitations. For safety reasons, passengers in wheelchairs cannot be carried on ramps in ports where the river or ocean cruise ship is at anchor.

Seat Rotation

Passengers rotate seats in the coach daily so everyone enjoys front and window seating. In fairness to all passengers, no exceptions can be made.

Health & Fitness

A good level of fitness and health is required to participate on APT's holiday packages. In some destinations there are extensive sightseeing excursions by foot which may include climbing of stairs. Mobility is needed to board and disembark coaches, river and ocean cruise ships and trains. We recommend a visit to the doctor and dentist before travelling. It is your responsibility to advise APT of any pre-existing medical conditions that may affect the normal conduct of a holiday package and the enjoyment of other passengers. A Health, Fitness & Mobility Questionnaire will be provided and requested to be completed at the time of booking if you advise of any health, fitness or mobility issues. APT is not liable for any injury, illness, or loss of enjoyment which could have been reasonably prevented had we been made aware of a pre-existing condition and been provided an opportunity to review it. We will not be responsible for any costs associated with cancellation penalties or the return of passengers from a tour, and a refund for lost touring cannot be claimed.

Visa & Passports

A valid passport is required with a minimum of six months validity from your date of return home. Note that visa and passport requirements are the responsibility of the traveller to organise and are subject to eligibility with government requirements. If travelling into Canada, all Australian, New Zealand and UK citizens must register on the Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) to determine eligibility to enter Canada. There is a fee of CAD\$7* payable in conjunction with the eTA registration (*subject to change). If travelling into the United States (including on an Alaska cruise), all Australian, New Zealand and UK citizens must register on the Electronic System for Travel Authorization (ESTA) to determine eligibility to travel to the US under the Visa Waiver Program (VWP). There is a fee of US\$14* payable in conjunction with the ESTA registration (*subject to change).

Airfares

Air travel is arranged with independent airlines. APT will arrange air travel as advertised in connection with your holiday package or as otherwise arranged with APT. All airfares are subject to flight and booking class availability. Airfares will be booked and ticketed upon receipt of your deposit to avoid price or tax increases. Airport taxes vary for each departure point and routing of airline. Airline schedules are subject to change without notice. Once air tickets are issued, airline amendment and/or cancellation fees apply and, in some cases, are non-refundable. Name changes and voluntary date and schedule changes will incur fees. APT is not liable for delays or disruptions of air travel.
