



General Information & Conditions:

The following terms and conditions ('booking conditions') form the basis of your contract with Australian Pacific Touring Pty Ltd ('APT', 'we' or 'our'). Please read them carefully as they set out your and our respective rights and obligations. By asking us to confirm your booking, we are entitled to assume that you have had the opportunity to read and have read these booking conditions, that you agree to them and that you agree to them applying to your holiday arrangements that you book with us and which we agree to make, provide or perform (as applicable) as part of our contract with you. References in these booking conditions to your 'holiday package' are references to the tour or cruise package you have booked with APT. References to 'excursions' are references to short trips or tours included or available as part of your holiday package.

Governing Law. These booking conditions are governed by the law in force in Victoria, Australia.

BEFORE YOU BOOK

Prices – Deposits – Discounts – Payments. Prices listed in this flyer are valid at the time of publication but are subject to change. They may be changed after the publication date for any reason, including without limitation, to cover changes in government taxes and charges, exchange rate variations, fuel surcharges, airline charges, a force majeure event or other material increases by suppliers.

Once the security deposit is paid the price will be guaranteed. A \$1,500 security deposit per person, per holiday package is required within seven days of booking confirmation. Deposit requirements may vary when booking a special offer. Final payment of the balance of your holiday package price is due 100 days prior. APT reserves the right to cancel any ticket or booking or, refuse to honour any price or carry any passenger where any payment has not been received by APT within the specified time. All fares and charges are in Australian currency. Payment in full is required at time of booking for reservations made less than 100 days before departure from Australia. If APT is unable to confirm your reservation, all monies will be refunded.

PHT Exclusive Group Departure. Requires a minimum number of bookings in order for the tour to be financially viable and to have a pleasant group atmosphere. In the event that adequate numbers cannot be achieved, it may be necessary to cancel this departure and offer the nearest similar possible alternative date (or a full refund of monies paid for arrangements made by APT)

Included in Our Land Tour Price. All coach, rail and cruise travel, accommodation, sightseeing, internal airfares, game park fees, gratuities, port charges, admissions, luggage service (one bag), local guides, services of a Tour Director, and meals (as specified and indicated in each individual itinerary).

Not Included in Our Land Tour Price. Airfares between Australia and Africa, optional tours, meals other than those specified in the itinerary, drinks, laundry, passport and visa fees, excess baggage and vaccinations. Rovos Rail is not included in the tour price. Changes to flight schedules may require you to book additional accommodation and services at your own expense.

Flights Within Africa. Economy flights within Africa and airport taxes are included in the price. This is based on passengers booking an international ticket to Africa with South African Airways with APT. A surcharge may apply if booking your own international flights from Australia. All internal flights must be booked by APT.

Airport Transfers. Airport transfers in Africa are included on the first and last day of your tour package. No refund will be given for unused transfers. Transfers cannot be re-routed to other pick-up points or destinations. Passengers who miss the pre-booked transfers must make their own way to/from the game lodge/hotel/ship at own expense. Transfers must be booked and details advised to APT at least 60 days prior to travel, otherwise transfers cannot be guaranteed.

Hotels. In more remote places, hotel, lodge and camp standards may not be quite as high as in major city centres. APT endeavours to utilise the most suitable accommodation available in each destination to ensure that passengers enjoy high levels of cleanliness, comfort and service. If a hotel change is necessary for any reason, APT will endeavour to ensure that alternative accommodation is of an equivalent standard to those shown. Hotel rooms are generally not available for check-in before 3 pm and require check-out by 10 am.

Twin or Double Rooms. Accommodation in all hotels, regardless of the rating, is in standard rooms (sometimes named superior) based on twins or doubles unless otherwise stated.

Solo Travellers. A limited number of single rooms may be available by request at time of booking your holiday package.

Rovos Rail Pre tour extension. Passengers will be assisted by Train Manager on Rovos Rail as the APT Tour Director will not accompany the extensions. Gratuities are not included on this extension.

Health & Fitness. A good level of fitness and health is required to participate on APT's holiday packages. Travel is in 4WD vehicles in game parks and in East Africa. Anyone with back conditions or limited mobility should seek advice from their doctor about joining this tour. Dust may also irritate contact lenses, therefore we suggest bringing glasses. In many of the cities and game lodges, walking is required on uneven ground and gravel paths, and good mobility is needed getting on/off 4WD vehicles, small planes, coaches, river ships and trains. We strongly recommend a visit to the doctor and dentist before travelling to overseas destinations. It is your responsibility to advise APT of any pre-existing medical conditions that may affect the normal conduct of a trip and the enjoyment of others while on tour. Yellow Fever vaccination is required.

Visa and Passports. All passengers must have a valid passport that is valid for at least six months after the holiday package return date. Passengers must have two blank pages available in their passports for their entry permit into South Africa. Passengers must consult with the appropriate consulates to ensure that they have any applicable visas for countries included in the holiday package prior to departure. Passengers are solely responsible for meeting necessary passport and visa entry requirements and paying all associated costs. APT cannot obtain group visas on your behalf. APT is not responsible for delays or missed portions of the holiday package resulting from incorrect travel documents or visas.

Travel Insurance. Travel Insurance is not included in your holiday package. You are required to purchase comprehensive travel insurance at the time of booking that includes (without limitation) coverage for the cost of your holiday package, medical expenses, loss of luggage, cruise and land content and airfare charges that may occur due to cancellation, impossibility of performance or other frustration, disruption, loss of deposit or strikes, and provide a copy to us.

Cancellation Policy. For all holiday packages in this brochure, the following APT cancellation fees will apply:

119-60 days	50% of holiday package price
59 days or less	100% of holiday package price

All cancellations must be received in writing by APT and are not effective until this notification has been received. If your holiday has commenced, 100% of the full holiday package price is charged. There is no refund for unused services or if portions of the holiday package are missed. Additional cancellation fees may also be charged in respect to accommodation reserved outside the holiday package dates. These cancellation fees are in addition to any fees that may be levied by APT and your travel agent (if any). You acknowledge that the amounts estimated under the Cancellation Policy are reasonable and

represent a genuine pre-estimate of APT's loss and are otherwise reasonably necessary to protect the legitimate interests of APT. If you request changes after APT has issued your documents, APT may charge you an administration and processing fee of \$70 per person in addition to any applicable cancellation fees.

Gantas Frequent Flyer Points. You must be a Gantas Frequent Flyer member to earn Gantas Points. A joining fee may apply. If you are not a Gantas Frequent Flyer member, you can join at gantas.com/Join. Membership and Gantas Points are subject to the Gantas Frequent Flyer Terms and Conditions, available at gantas.com/terms. Gantas Points will be earned on bookings made in Australian Dollars from 1 May 2018. Members must add a valid Gantas Frequent Flyer number and surname to their booking before the trip departure date. Gantas Frequent Flyer members can earn 2 Gantas Points per AUS\$1 spent on APT holidays that include a Luxury River Cruise (of seven days or longer) and 1 Gantas Point per AUS\$1 spent on all other APT holidays. Gantas Points will be credited to the Gantas Frequent Flyer member's account within seven days of the trip departure date. Members will not earn Gantas Points on airfares bundled with an APT holiday; where a member cancels their APT holiday prior to the date of departure; APT holidays booked with staff, companion or Friends and Family discounts; travel industry member discounts; press and partnership trips; or prizewinners. You can check the Gantas Points that you have earned with APT and your total points balance at gantaspoints.com/your-account. Standard APT Booking Terms and Conditions apply. APT reserve the right to change, suspend or terminate these Terms and Conditions at any time.

Disruption to Itinerary Arrangements. Itineraries are intended as a guide only and are subject to alteration without notice. Alterations may be necessary for various reasons including, without limitation, road, river or weather conditions, strikes or airline schedule changes, and other reasons beyond APT's control. If conditions render any routes unsafe for navigation, APT reserves the right to provide alternative services including, but not limited to, accommodation on the docked ship or substitute land arrangements. Sometimes for reasons beyond our control, it may be necessary to make alterations to your itinerary.

Travel Insurance for East Africa. All passengers are required to carry valid travel insurance. As part of your pre-departure forms we will require travel insurance carrier, policy number and a 24 hour contact number for travel to East Africa.

Luggage Limits. Each passenger is entitled to take one case up to 20kg. For travel in Kenya, Tanzania there are luggage restrictions due to travelling in 4WD vehicles and flying in smaller planes where you will need to pack down to a soft bag of 15kg. APT will provide a soft bag for you to use in East Africa. Excess Luggage can be stored while in East Africa. Airlines permit only one cabin bag per person, in which personal items such as cameras, makeup etc. should be carried. Over-limit luggage cannot be carried. Baggage is at 'owner's risk'.

***Tour Escort.** A tour escort is subject to a minimum number of passengers traveling from Australia. If the minimum number is not met, the tour may travel without a tour escort. Phil Hoffmann Travel reserve the right to revise pricing should minimum numbers not be met.

Day 01, 15 June: Arrive Victoria Falls

On arrival, you'll be met and transferred to The Victoria Falls Hotel. Enjoy dinner at the hotel. **D**
Two Nights: The Victoria Falls Hotel.

Day 02, 16 June: Victoria Falls

Accompanied by a guide, walk through the rainforest and along a path to the edge of the falls. Be prepared to brave the tremendous spray as you take in amazing views. Raincoats are provided when required. Tonight, take a trip back to the age of romantic steam train travel, as the restored Dinner Run Train jaunts onto the famous Victoria Falls Bridge. **BD**

Day 03, 17 June: Chobe Riverfront

Cross into Botswana and travel by coach and boat into Namibia where you will stay on the banks of the Chobe in your own water villa. This afternoon, embark on a river safari. **BLD**
Two Nights: Chobe Water Villas.

Day 04, 18 June: Chobe Riverfront

A 4x4 vehicle will take you through Chobe National Park while your guide locates a variety of wildlife. In the afternoon, take a boat cruise along the Chobe and Zambezi rivers. **BLD**

Day 05, 19 June: Johannesburg

Stay: Johannesburg, Peermont D'oreale Grande Hotel at Emperors Palace.

Day 06, 20 June: Arusha

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Dar es Salaam. On arrival, you will be assisted in joining your connecting scheduled flight to Arusha, where you'll be whisked to Arusha Coffee Lodge to enjoy a cocktail party. **B**

Stay: Elewana Arusha Coffee Lodge.

Day 07, 21 June: Tarangire National Park

Visit a traditional Masai Village and learn about their unique way of life, before driving into Tarangire National Park. This afternoon, you will set out on a game drive with an experienced game tracker and driver leading the way. You'll stay out on the plains as the sun sets – the best time to view wildlife. **BLD**

Two Nights: Tarangire Balloon Camp.

Day 08, 22 June: Tarangire National Park

Today, enjoy morning and afternoon game drives through the wilds of Tarangire National Park. Elephants are abundant, as are zebra. And keep your eyes peeled for lions lazing in the sun. **BLD**

Day 09, 23 June: Karatu

After breakfast today, visit a local school in Karatu. Enjoy lunch at your lodge before an entire afternoon and evening to yourself. **BLD**

Two Nights: Karatu, Acacia Farm Lodge.

Day 10, 24 June: Ngorongoro Crater, Karatu

Head to Ngorongoro Crater for a full-day game drive. Here, the expanses of savannah and bush extend in all directions, creating the perfect habitats for over 25,000 animals. Amongst large populations of wildebeest, zebra, eland, and gazelles. In the evening, ascend back up the crater walls and drive back to your lodge in time for dinner. **BLD**

Day 11, 25 June: Olduvai Gorge, Serengeti National Park

Drive to Olduvai Gorge, known as the 'cradle of mankind' due to evidence of early humans been discovered here. On the way to your next camp, you'll take a game drive in Serengeti National Park, whose plains are home to an incredible amount of animals. See how endless dry grasslands collide with a brilliant sky. **BLD**

Three Nights: Serengeti National Park, Ole Serai Luxury Camp Turner Springs or similar.

Day 12, 26 June: Serengeti National Park

Get ready for another full-day game drive throughout Serengeti National Park. In the evening, return to your camp for dinner, then relax with a drink on your deck and enjoy the sounds of the African bush. **BLD**

Day 13, 27 June: Serengeti National Park

Dedicate the entire day to exploring the Serengeti on a game drive. With an experienced game tracker and driver, you'll seek out an array of wildlife as you navigate your way through the awe-inspiring landscapes. **BLD**

Day 14, 28 June: Masai Mara
