MONDAY

Mid-afternoon board the majestic PS Murray Princess in historic Mannum, the birthplace of the Murray River trade and communication. Settle into your cabin and enjoy an afternoon beverage while taking in the scenery and meeting your fellow passengers.

Tonight, enjoy a Welcome Dinner in the Sturt Dining Room and be entertained by the on-board entertainer, before retiring to your cabin. **Overnight: Mannum.**

TUESDAY

We depart Mannum early morning, and cruise down river towards Murray Bridge. After lunch, we arrive in Murray Bridge where you can choose to join a guided tour of the town's historic landmarks and local attractions or go on a wildlife tour at Monarto Safari Park (additional cost).

Late afternoon, we depart Murray Bridge and continue our journey upriver towards Mundurra. After dinner, participate in a table quiz challenge and test your knowledge while having fun. **Overnight: Mundurra.**

WEDNESDAY

Depart Mundurra early morning and cruise upriver while taking in the tranquillity as the landscape slides by. Catch up with friends over a coffee or drink whilst enjoying the magnificent scenery.

After lunch, we secure at Salt Bush Flat where you can join a guided nature walk where our guide will share the secrets of the local flora and fauna. It's a great way to get in a little exercise before the PS Murray Princess departs and cruises upriver towards Curnamont for our overnight mooring.

Tonight, be entertained by our talented crew in the Sturt Dining Room. **Overnight: Curnamont.**

THURSDAY

Daybreak and it's time for the keen photographers to be out to capture the special light and the morning movement of wildlife. Prolific birdlife includes pelicans, wrens and swans. Enjoy a leisurely morning while watching the picturesque scenery pass by.

Near Fromms Landing, we turn and head downriver to River View Lodge (near Piggy Flat / Coolcha) where your discovery vessel awaits for a wildlife tour. Travelling in small, personalised groups, we explore the maze of the river and the birdlife is amazing. Watch for darters, herons and egrets feeding along the river's muddy edges.

The afternoon offers a choice of bocce or fishing challenges before a delicious final night dinner in the Sturt Dining Room.

Tonight, join your fellow passengers for a delicious final night dinner and enjoy the evening entertainment. **Overnight: River View Lodge.**

FRIDAY

We leave River View Lodge and head back to Mannum. After breakfast we reluctantly say farewell as we arrive at the Mannum Wharf.

BAROSSA WINE AND HERITAGE TOUR

Available on conclusion of the 4 Night Outback Heritage Cruise.

Depart Mannum, and travel into the famous Barossa, Australia's richest and best-known wine making region.

Your first stop is at **Jacob's Creek Visitor Centre**, where you will enjoy a light morning tea while taking in the breath-taking views over the vineyards. You will have the opportunity to participate in a structured wine tasting before departing and heading to Lambert Estate in Angaston for lunch.

Enjoy a two-course lunch at **Lambert Estate**, incorporating fresh regional produce available in season. Pair this with a glass of wine (own cost) and take in the magnificent outlook from the deck of this popular vineyard.

Next visit **Maggie Beer's Farm Shop**, and learn about Maggie and her story, as well as the history behind the Farm. You'll have an opportunity to taste some delicious Maggie Beer and Pheasant Farm products and take a photo in her famous kitchen.

If time permits, purchase some afternoon tea from the cafe (own expense) and take in the peaceful surrounds of the lake and resident birdlife.

Following Maggie Beer's, you'll make your way by coach through the picturesque regions of **Seppeltsfield and Marananga** which is home to many iconic cellar doors. No trip to the Barossa is complete without visiting Seppeltsfield Road which is full of history and lined with distinctive palm trees.

Sit back, relax and enjoy the scenery as you travel back through the picturesque **Eden Valley**. View the Murrayland flats from atop Palmer hill as you descend into Mannum where you will re-board the Murray Princess, or transfer to a luxury coach for your journey back to Adelaide

Departs at 9.30am on Friday from Mannum and concludes 5.30pm in Adelaide or Adelaide Airport at approximately 6.00pm.
