





TARNIA BOYCE TASMANIA

I recently returned from 4 nights in Western Tasmania a World Heritagelisted wilderness with rainforests, mountains and glacial valleys. Highlights included the Bonorong Wildlife Sanctuary for close encounters with native animals, a Gordon River heritage cruise, and Cradle Mountain. Tasmania's culinary adventure delighted with fresh seafood and local cheeses. Travel tip - Allow extra driving time for windy roads on a selfdriven tour and at least 2 days at Cradle Mountain for walking tracks and wombat sightings. This journey left memories of nature's splendour, wildlife encounters, and culinary delights. I highly recommend this region to anyone seeking an escape into the untouched Australian wilderness.



ANDREA MIRRA TURKEY

I recently had an amazing tour of Turkey. We spent the morning on the Gallipoli Peninsula and explored historical cities including Pergamon, Ephesus, and Konya. Pamukkale's white calcium terraces and Cappadocia's captivating landscapes stood out. A hot air balloon ride in Cappadocia fulfilled a bucket list dream. In Istanbul, we visited Sultan Ahmed Mosque, Hagia Sophia (tip: visit after 8:00 pm to avoid crowds), and the Basilica Cistern. Before heading home, we enjoyed a 3-night stopover in Dubai, and enjoyed a Desert Safari (tip: opt for early morning departure to avoid heat). Turkey's history, landscapes and adventures made for an unforgettable journey.

SHADES OF IRELAND

Whether you're strolling through picturesque Georgian streets or sipping a pint at the fabled Guinness brewery, Dublin quickly has you hooked. 




