





DAY 1 | 15 NOV 2024 Arrive Norfolk Island

Stay: South Pacific Resort—7 nights

Meet Paul, your Phil Hoffmann Tour Escort at Adelaide Airport and board your flight to Norfolk Island. On arrival you'll be met, transferred to your resort, unpack and settle in before enjoying a welcome drink and talk about what to expect during your trip. Over dinner at the hotel you'll enjoy a delicious roast carvery, followed by 'Wonderland by Night'. This is set among 10 acres of magical Norfolk pines and bushland lit up like an enchanted forest where a local poet recites their poems while lighting up dioramas. (D)

DAY 2 | 16 NOV 2024 Norfolk Island

After breakfast, take a half-day tour of Norfolk Island. Visit historic Kingston and see the famous convict buildings, beautiful beaches and golf course; tour the Melanesian Chapel; see Government, law and lifestyle. Enjoy views from scenic spots on this full commentary tour. Enjoy a 2-course lunch at Bounty Bar & Grill with the afternoon free. Later enjoy a feast of island dishes -- salads, homemade bread and fresh fried fish followed by island desserts and tea or coffee (BYO drinks). Enjoy the beautiful scenery from Puppy's Point on Norfolk Island's beautiful western coastline as well as some local entertainment followed by a Sound & Light Show. Nightfall at Kingston brings a different mood to the Convict Settlement: stillness and stars just as before mankind arrived in 1788 but with dramatic use of real-life sounds and theatrical lighting paired with costumed actors portraying convict life here during its darkest years, it becomes clear how harsh living conditions were for those who found themselves trapped here. DAY 3 | 17 NOV 2024 Norfolk Island

This morning, take a leisurely walk along the Bridle Track to the Captain Cook Monument. Meet on the clifftop for a delicious barbecue breakfast. Relax and enjoy ocean views as you eat your breakfast! In the afternoon, enjoy a light lunch at the hotel before embarking to visit Colleen McCullough's home on Norfolk Island. Colleen McCullough-world-renowned author of 24 books-called Norfolk Island home for almost 36 years. She and husband Ric Robinson created a luxurious hideaway where she could write her most powerful titles. Some of these titles were created in this much-loved sanctuary. In the evening, enjoy warm hospitality from Island families during a progressive 3 course dinner including wine or bring your own if you prefer. (B,L,D)

DAY 4 | 18 NOV 2024 Norfolk Island

After breakfast at the hotel, you'll travel to Anson Bay to visit a small hobby farm for the "Over the Cattlestops" tour. The farm has been instrumental in improving the local livestock industry. Then see a demonstration at Norfolk's major pottery barn and browse the Cottage Pottery Shop. After a delicious morning tea at a scenic location, learn about the colorful history of Norfolk Island's most recent settlement - Pitcairners and their descendants before heading out for a 2-course dinner at a homestead restaurant. DAY 5 | 19 NOV 2024 Norfolk Island

After breakfast this morning, you'll be picked up from the hotel for a tour of some of the island's lovely gardens. Enjoy morning tea with spectacular views and lunch at a café before visiting an amazing 360° panoramic painting. The Cyclorama provides a total experience, bringing to life the history of the Norfolk Island people and their connection with the infamous mutiny on the 'Bounty.' This evening is sure to be a highlight: Dress as a convict and join in with the Commandant for an evening of gaiety, feasting, singing and dancing. Great food! Great fun! (Outfit supplied.) (B,MT,D)

DAY 6 | 20 NOV 2024 Norfolk Island

This morning is at your leisure. Later today, you will board a Glass Bottom Boat, as the captain shares their knowledge of Norfolk's unique marine life. View beautiful coral gardens and tropical fish inside the calm crystal waters of Norfolk's lagoon. This evening, enjoy a lantern lit dinner at a historic Georgian Building. (B,D)



DAY 7 | 21 NOV 2024 Norfolk Island

Join an 'In Depth' tour of the historic Georgian settlement of Kingston. Walk through the cemetery and hear the history of interesting convict and colonial headstones, as well as stories about the houses along Quality Row. Return back to the hotel for lunch. This evening is guaranteed to be fun; enjoy a 3-course meal fit for the commandants en-route to solving a mystery. (B,L,D)

DAY 8 | 22 NOV 2024 Farewell Norfolk Island

This morning, enjoy breakfast at the South Pacific Hotel before being transferred to the airport for your flight home. (B)
